Internet Explorer 11 is having compatibility issues with Webpoint and the LMS system. Firefox is the recommended web browser for Webpoint (membership database) but Google Chrome can also be used when working in the membership database or LMS clinic website. If you choose to work in Internet Explorer, there is a work-around. You must add usavolleyball.org to your compatibility view settings. To do this, open Internet Explorer 11. Find the Tools menu, then click the Compatibility View Settings option and click it. Type usavolleyball.org and click Add. This should add that website to the list below. When it has been added, click Close. This will allow the membership database (Webpoint) to run properly. If you have any questions, contact the Great Plains Region office.
