The Great Plains region has a signing date of Nov 2 for ages 10-14 and Sun, Nov 17 for ages 15-18. This is the only date the region will honor when a player signs the letter of commitment to play with a club. You can verbally commit at any time at your own discretion. Also, for several years now, the Great Plains Region board elected not to be involved in any monetary exchange or refunds between club and player.

The North American, Central American and Caribbean Continental championships "NOR-CE-CA" were played all week at the Ralston Arena in Ralston, NE from Mon, Sept 16 to Sat, Sept 21. Matches were at 4, 6 & 8pm The average attendance was about 2000 a day. The USA Women won the Gold behind the efforts of former Great Plains region member Jordan Larson. They beat Dominican Republic 3 sets to 1. A BIG thanks go out to Sue Mailhot and Michelle Hayes for coordinating all the volunteer workers to help make the event a success. It took over 22 volunteers to make one match happen. In all, there were over 104 volunteers that worked the event. The volleyball teams of Omaha Warriors and Briar Cliff University worked several matches. But we would like to thank all who volunteered and worked matches.

All membership registration fees should be paid by individual members. All members should register and pay individually through the online registration system on the Great Plains Region website. It is not acceptable to pay your club and have them send the money in for you. All signatures will be accepted electronically on-line. There are no papers to send to the office for membership registration. Memberships can be paid by credit card (Visa & MasterCard) online at the time of registration.

The Responsible Sports Community Grant is a free, competition-based fundraising program for youth sports organizations. Teams, clubs and schools from around the country register to participate. Once approved to compete, organizations rally their adult supporters to take a Responsible Sport Parenting or Responsible Coaching quiz and credit the point to the organization.
